

EMERGENCY & FIRST AID PROCEDURES

(For Use at the Baptist Church in Melton Mowbray.)

In an **emergency** call 999 using the nearest Telephone or Mobile and depending on the nature of the emergency ask for:

Ambulance/First Responder
Fire and Rescue
Police

Non – emergency Numbers are:

NHS 111 – for medical help and advice if medical treatment is needed quickly, and you cannot wait for an appointment to see a doctor.

First Aid

First Aid boxes are located in the Foyer and the Kitchen whilst in emergencies, **Defibrillators** can be found at the Bowls Club and the Melton Building Society Offices.
