### **Introduction.**

The huge cotton mill was the heart of working life at Quarry Bank. Find out about Samuel Greg and his journey from being a young boy in Belfast to the building of his cotton business. Visit Quarry Bank House and its gardens together with the Weaving Shed Restaurant or the Garden Café and Stables view Quarry Bank as a perfect example of early Industrial Revolution social change where intellectuals, politicians, artists and industrialists mixed with ease and strolled in the gardens where the family relaxed alongside the Apprentice House where as many as 90 children who worked in the mill lived in exchange for food, clothes and board.

**Note 1:** The cost of the trip includes coach travel, parking, gratuities and a guided tour of the Mill, together with access to the House and Gardens etc. Assisted transport is available for those unable to manage the steeper gradients.

- For **NT members** the cost will be £22.00 per person on **production of valid NT Membership Card on the day, (otherwise full costs apply).**
- The cost for **Non NT Members** will be an extra £17.00, i.e. £39.00 in total.
